

First Baptist Church Soccer Camp COVID-19

Updated July 20, 2020

First Baptist Church soccer camp has implemented many procedures to minimize exposure of our campers, our volunteers and our community to the COVID-19 virus.

- All campers and volunteers will be asked to stay home if they or someone in their home is experiencing Covid-19 like symptoms.
 - Persistent cough
 - Difficulty breathing
 - Fever over 100.4°F
 - Body chills or muscle Aches and pains
 - Sore throat
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - Diarrhea, nausea or vomiting
- All campers/volunteers and their drives will be temperature screened upon arrival. If you fail the screening (>100.4F), you will be asked to return home.
- Masks
 - All parents/guardians are strongly encouraged to wear a mask when on the church property. You are welcome to stay and watch, but must social distance and field access is not allowed.
 - All campers are encouraged to wear a mask unless engaged in physically strenuous activity
 - All coaches/volunteers are strongly encouraged to wear a mask unless engaged in physically strenuous activity or speaking to a large group.
 - Coaches and campers will not be required to wear a mask during play, since un-hindered breathing is required for the sport.
- Hand sanitizer will be distributed to all campers at check in, prior to the snack, and will be available at the bathrooms. Bathrooms will be cleaned multiple times a day, with a hand washing station nearby.
- All snacks will be individually portioned, to minimize handling.
- Water will be made available, but the campers will open and close their own bottles. Everyone is encourage to bring enough water for the camp each day.
- Enrollment is limited, and the K-1 grade age group has been suspended for this year.
- Grade groups will not intermingle with the other grade groups during the camp.
- Social distancing will be encouraged when possible. Social distancing during the soccer games is impractical due to the nature of the sport.
- These rules may change as more information becomes available. Please check frequently.
